Veteran-founded in 2012, The Headstrong Project is a non-profit mental health organization that provides barrier-free, confidential, stigma-free PTSD treatment to veterans, service members, and family members connected to their care.

Headstrong's mission is to help clients "Triumph Over Trauma" by providing best-in-class outpatient care delivered via an extensive network of military-connected clinicians carefully selected for each client based on their individual needs.

Since its inception, Headstrong has provided more than 218,000 mental health sessions to thousands of service members, veterans, and military family members, regardless of era or service status. Headstrong offers in-person treatment in 17 states, plus D.C., and can serve clients in all 50 states via telehealth.

LETTER FROM THE CEO

During my 20+ years of service in the United States Marine Corps, I learned that success in any mission depends on trust, speed, and precision. In combat, you rely on your team with your life. But when service ends, too many of our nation's warriors face a different battle—one they never trained for and must navigate alone. At The Headstrong Project, we refuse to let that happen.

2024 was a year of remarkable progress. We delivered over 44,000 clinical sessions, expanded care into North Carolina and Ohio, and laid the groundwork to provide 250,000 additional therapy sessions and expand in-person care to 31 states by 2029. Our newly established Scientific Advisory Board is ensuring we remain at the forefront of evidence-based mental health care. We've accelerated treatment access, strengthened family therapy programs, and invested in technology to improve the speed, consistency, and confidentiality of care.

But our impact is best measured by the ripple effect of helping just one veteran. When a veteran heals, their family heals. Their relationships, careers, and futures regain stability. Communities grow stronger. And through Headstrong, this transformation happens at no cost, with no red tape, and with results that last—because 97% of our clients return for follow-up care, and the vast majority report life-changing improvement.








DRIVING CLINICAL EXCELLENCE

The Headstrong Project continues to advance the future of veteran mental health care through innovative clinical initiatives.

In 2024, we focused on three key areas to improve treatment outcomes, enhance effectiveness, and reduce barriers to care.







ENHANCING EFFECTIVENESS MEET THE SCIENTIFIC ADVISORY BOARD

In 2024, Headstrong introduced its first-ever Scientific Advisory Board, bringing new **expertise** and **oversight** to the organization's clinical programming.


The Advisory Board is comprised of experts specializing in the treatment of PTSD and co-occurring presentations in veterans and service members.

FASTER HEALING, GREATER IMPACT ACCELERATED TREATMENT

In March 2024, we introduced a **pilot program** for Accelerated Treatment using Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR).

This approach delivers therapy at an increased pace, allowing clients to see **results faster** while reducing dropout rates and expanding our capacity to **serve more veterans**. With Cognitive Processing Therapy (CPT) and Prolonged Exposure (PE) set to launch in 2025, this initiative will continue to evolve.





STRENGTHENING SUPPORT SYSTEMS FAMILY THERAPY

Recognizing the profound impact of trauma on family relationships, we are launching a specialized family therapy intervention. This 8-12 session program provides psychoeducation and skills training to help families navigate the challenges of trauma recovery. With research showing that strong family support improves PTSD outcomes and reduces suicide risk, this program is a vital expansion of our services.

By investing in these innovative approaches, Headstrong continues to lead the way in providing cutting-edge, evidence-based care for veterans and their loved ones.





IMPACT IN ACTION CLINICIAN STORY

2024 CLINICIAN OF THE YEAR DR. MIA BARTOLETTI SHARES WHY SHE PARTNERS WITH THE HEADSTRONG PROJECT



As a nation, we ask our service men and women to accomplish the unimaginable. In the course of their missions, they experience trauma at a rate and frequency rarely seen in the civilian world. Unfortunately, we do not adequately prepare them for what these experiences do to the human condition, and a persistent stigma tells them that any feelings of sadness or regret are signs of weakness.

I have spent hundreds of clinical hours with military and veteran patients through Headstrong, and thousands more working with the United States Navy and members of the special forces. Not once have I encountered an individual who I would describe as weak. My clients are courageous, resilient, and elite by many measures, and they make me immensely proud to carry out this work.

This organization's affirmation that we can Triumph Over Trauma is a fact backed by medical evidence. Emotional pain and suffering are treatable. And nobody does it better than Headstrong.






IMPACT IN ACTION CLIENT STORY



EXPANDING COVERAGE

This past year, Headstrong expanded its in-person services to Ohio and North Carolina. Through Mission: Any Veteran, Anywhere, Headstrong will continue its commitment to ensuring veterans across the nation have access to the mental health care they need by expanding in-person therapy services to two to three states each year.

In 2025, the organization will launch in-person treatment for service members, veterans, and military family members in South Carolina, Michigan, and Montana.



The Headstrong Project's Annual NYC Gala was a night of exceptional impact, and thanks to incredible supporters like you, we raised a record-breaking **\$5 million** for life-saving mental health care for veterans!

The evening, presented by Carlisle Companies Incorporated, included a powerful keynote address from General Jim Mattis who shared an important reminder: "What mission could be more important than helping our veterans who are struggling both in body and mind with what they experienced in combat while keeping the rest of us safe?"

We presented Headstrong's **2024 Moral Courage Award** to **Bob Parsons** in recognition of his extraordinary efforts to share his own experience recovering from PTSD to help reduce the stigma of struggling with mental health challenges.

Longtime supporter **Jake Gyllenhaal** introduced a moving video highlighting the story of former Headstrong client **Geoff Ball**, the commanding officer of "Ghost Company," 2nd Battalion, 1st Marine Regiment, during the U.S. evacuation from Afghanistan in 2021.

The gala marked the 20th anniversary of the Battle of Fallujah, a defining chapter in Headstrong's story, commemorated by our Co-founder, U.S. Marine Corps veteran **Zach Iscol**.

Zach's fellow Co-founder **Al Rabil** shared, "You, like me, know that our freedom would not exist, and our lives would not be what they are without our veterans." His words served as a powerful reminder of why we gathered and why Headstrong's mission is vital.
