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# TRIUMPH OVER TRAUMA

Veteran-founded in 2012, The Headstrong Project is a non-profit mental health organization that provides barrier-free, cost-free, stigma-free PTSD treatment to veterans, transitioning service members, and family members connected to their care.

Headstrong's mission is to help clients "Triumph Over Trauma" by providing best-in-class outpatient care delivered via an extensive network of military-connected clinicians carefully selected for each client based on their individual needs.

Since its inception, Headstrong has provided more than 270,000 mental health sessions to thousands of service members, veterans, and military family members, regardless of era or service status. Headstrong offers in-person treatment in 20 states, plus D.C., and can serve clients in all 50 states via telehealth.

# A MESSAGE FROM **OUR CEO**

In my years of service in the U.S. Marine Corps, I learned that when the mission is clear, you move with urgency and you don't leave people behind. At The Headstrong Project, that principle guides how we operate every day.

In 2025, our clinicians delivered more than 52,000 therapy sessions to nearly 3,000 veterans, service members, and family members. We surpassed 270,000 sessions since our founding, a milestone that reflects both the scale of need and the trust placed in our care. We expanded into three new states, bringing in-person treatment to 20 nationwide, while maintaining an average of just 12 days from intake to first appointment.

We are advancing our model to deliver better outcomes in less time. Accelerated treatment options are helping veterans make progress faster, reducing dropout, and allowing us to serve more people with the resources we have. Our family therapy program is building on that progress, strengthening outcomes by ensuring veterans don't have to navigate treatment alone and that their families are also supported throughout the process.

Our progress is being met with increased demand. In 2025, outreach to Headstrong increased by 20%, reflecting both rising need and growing trust in our care. This acceleration in demand is a reminder that this mission isn't slowing down, and that every veteran who reaches out deserves to be met with timely, high-quality care.

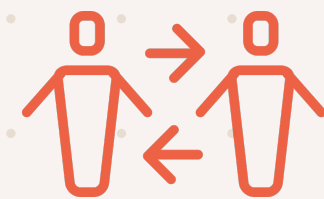

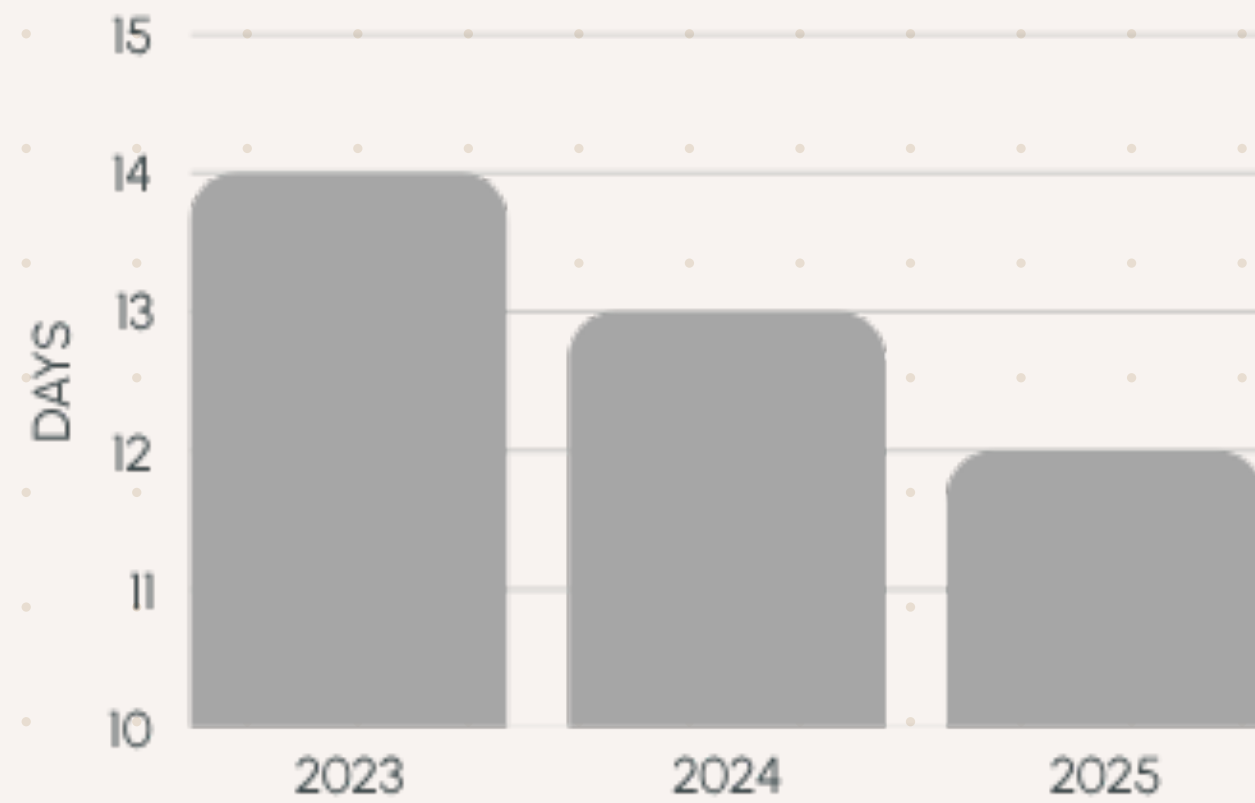

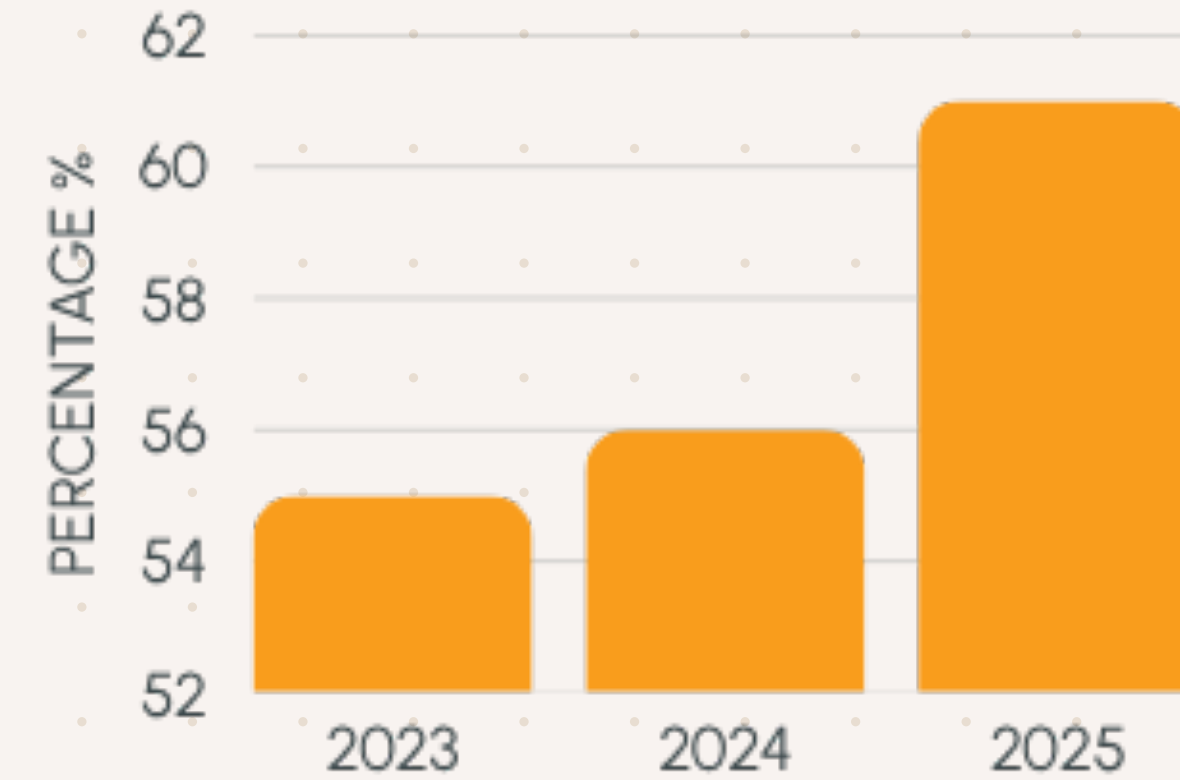

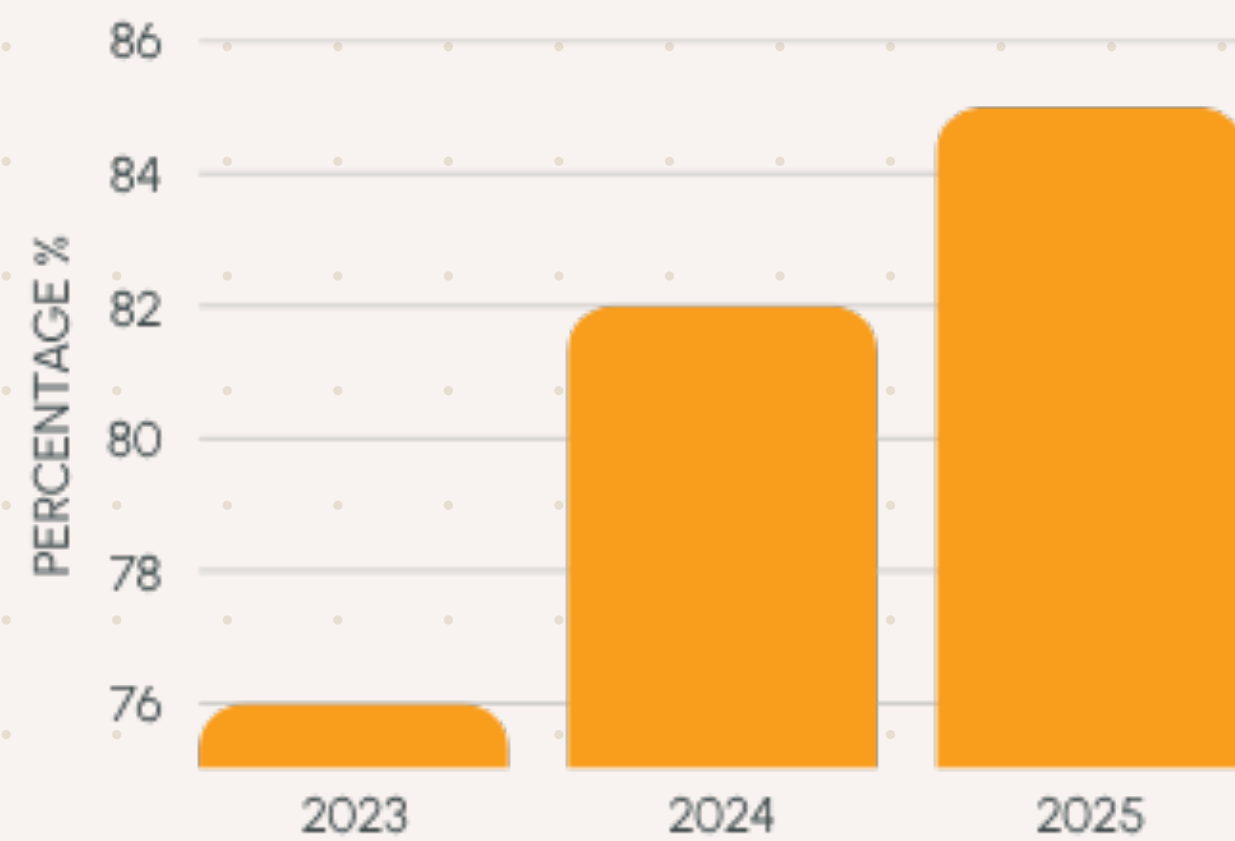
AVERAGE TIME TO CARE



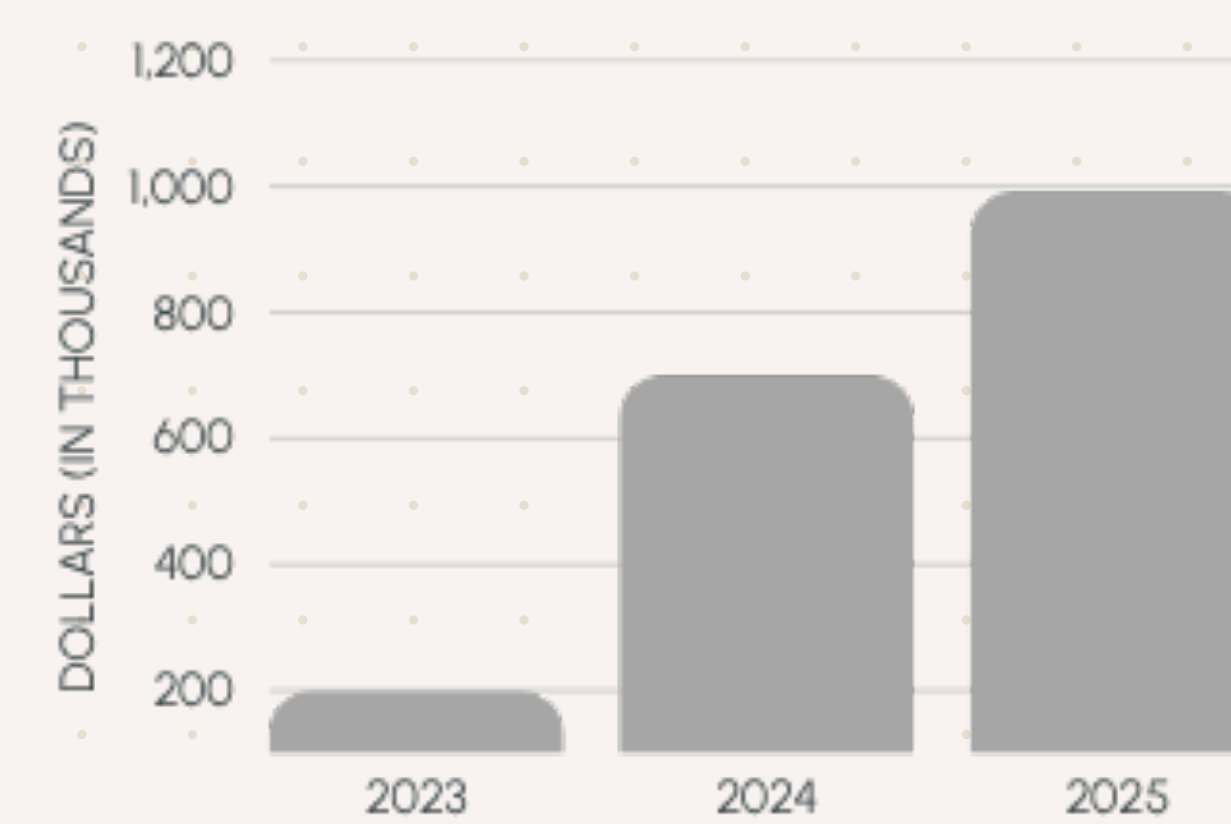
REDUCTION OF PTSD SYMPTOMS



PROGRAM EFFICIENCY RATIO



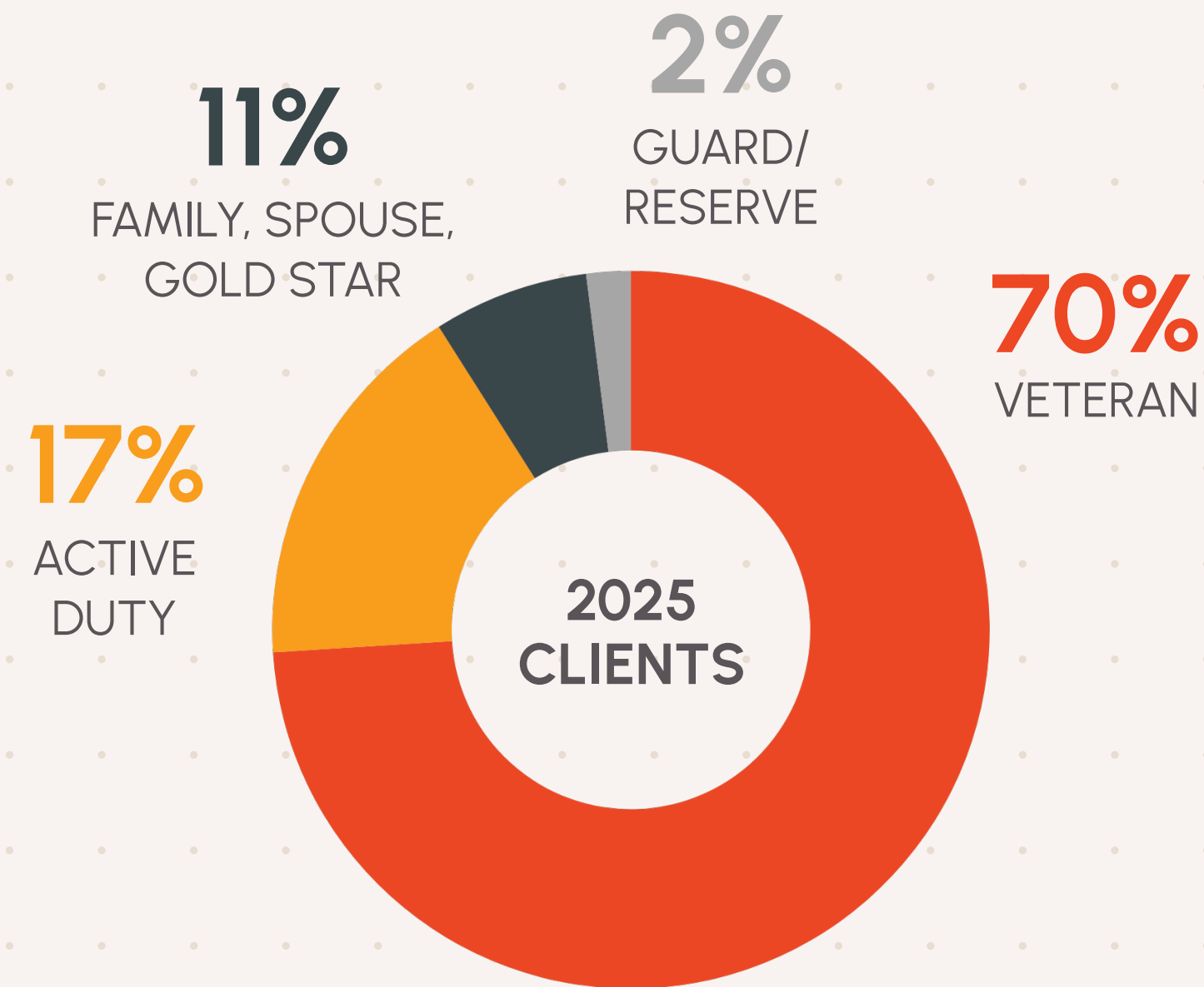

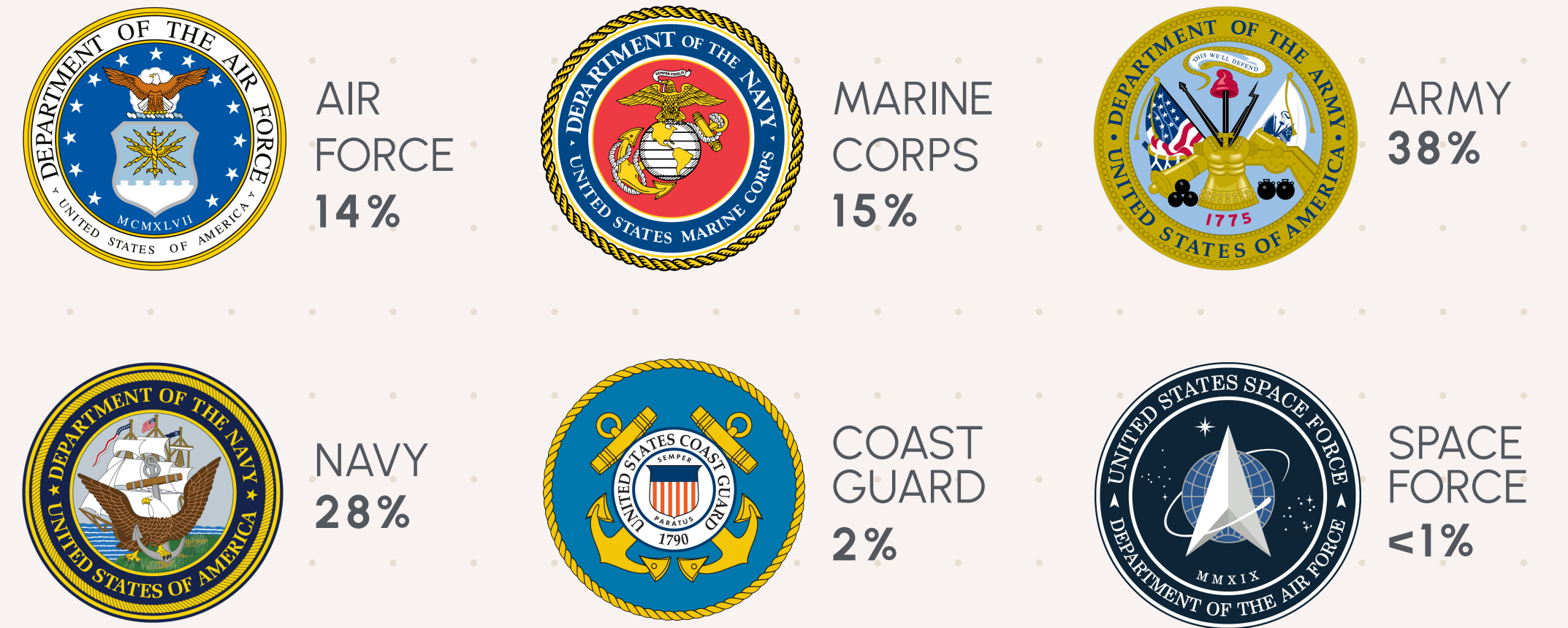

As clinicians, we know that once someone reaches out for help, every passing hour adds to the likelihood that they will not go through with therapy. Headstrong's intake process is the keystone upholding the connection between veterans and treatment. And when a service member or veteran receives treatment, their loved ones share in the healing process.

One of my recent clients came to me after nearly 25 years with the Army Special Forces. He spent three quarters of that time separated from his wife and children. When they finally reunited, after all he had endured, he struggled to empathize with them, and they were beginning to break apart.

Fortunately, we were able to rebuild this veteran's connection to his family. Not only is he in a better place now, but his wife has her husband back and his children finally have their father. Recovery stories like this happen every day, thanks to Headstrong, and I am so honored to be a part of the team.

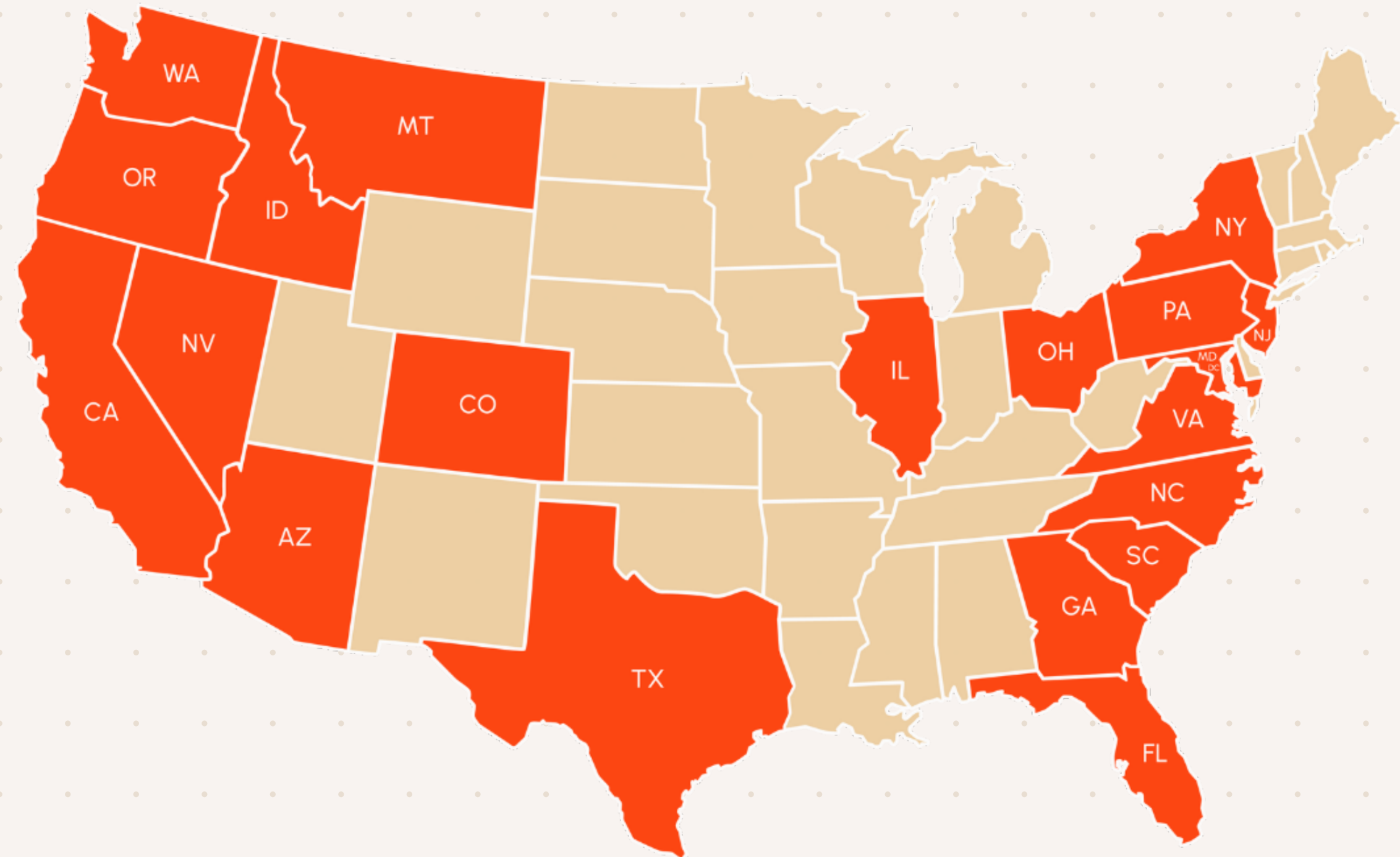


# EXPANDING COVERAGE

This past year, Headstrong expanded its in-person services to Montana, Nevada, and South Carolina.
